League Notes

Team name change: Wolfpack has finally come up with a name for their team and they shall be known as "Wolfpack".

Team captains must review player information in leaguesys (<https://www.leaguesys.net/juneau/default.aspx>). Make sure your players names are listed correctly. We are missing many last names with new players this year. When filling out your scoresheet list everyone first and last name.

Identify who paid their weekly fees by marking amount paid next to each players name. If a player is paying their player fee make sure to mark that next to the player's name. Sub players must also be clearly marked as a sub or they will be added to your team. Mark the \$10 sub fee clearly next to their name as well. (Sub fee is separate from the weekly fee so a sub is \$10 fee plus \$10 weekly for \$20). Sub will pay \$20 for 1st 2 weeks of play and \$15 for 3rd week by then their full \$25 player fee will have been paid.

Identify break and runs by circling the 10. Mark table runs (opponent runs the table right after the break) with a TR next to the 10.

All match fees must be paid timely. We will begin identifying those players who have not paid in a future newsletter. These players may also be ineligible to play until the fees are paid in full.

Failed Geometry (125) vs. 4 Tlingits & Pretty Fly 4 a White Guy (118)

Lockanne Keyes won the first game of the match 10-2 over Nick Hotchuncle (we know this is not his real name but the team captain still needs to get us all correct information!) Larry Hotch and Bobby Brakes won the next 2 games for Pretty Fly at 10-3 and 10-5. Michael Moore and Ryan Isturis pulled off 10-7 wins to end the first round 38 to 36 in favor of Failed Geometry. In the second round, Rex Sage, Rachael Blea and Michael got wins for Failed Geometry to win the second round 41 to 38 and extend the overall lead to 5 points 79 to 74. Bobby won the first game of the last round 10-5 to tie the match. Rex won the second game 10-4 and Failed Geometry was back up by 6 points. Ben Hotch won 10-6 to pull within 2 points and Larry Hotch won the next game 10-6 to give Pretty Fly a 2 point lead with one game left. Michael Moore led Failed Geometry with a 26.

Off Constantly (118) vs. Black-n-Gold (97)

Gerry Carrillo, Off Constantly, table ran Matt Schimming after Matt did not sick a ball on the break for a 10-0 win to start the match. Rick Paulo, Off Constantly, beat Ken Southerland 10-6 then Monty Lingley, Mark Rackley and Steve Schick won the next 3 games for Black-n-Gold to tie the match 36-36 after round 1. Gerry, Rick and Paul Canik won the first 3 games of the 2nd round for Off Constantly.
